Lent Begins March 1

We always try to add more prayer to our lives during the Lenten season and we have scheduled several extra prayer activities during Lent here at school. Parents are invited to join us for any of these.

Every Friday afternoon that we are in school the children will lead the Stations of the Cross at 2:00. On Good Friday, April 14, our eighth grade students will lead us in the Living Stations of the Cross. If you can only join

us for one Stations during Lent, I know that you will be moved by the Living Stations, at 10:00 am or at 12:00 noon. It is worth coming during a lunch break to join us in the holy prayer activity.

Every Monday morning we will have a special lenten prayer service, again led by various grades in the school. We are also adding extra daily prayer in each classroom and giving alms to the poor during lent. Look for your Rice Bowls that

come home on Ash Wednesday, March 1. We suggest keeping a rice bowl on your dinner table and adding change throughout Lent.

The church asks that we approach lent in three ways, by adding prayer, giving to the poor and trying to sacrifice something. Help your child plan these three good works during Lent, and by Easter morning we will all be refreshed and renewed in our love of Jesus.

We Need Your Help with Fish Fry

As you know, the cost of educating a child at Holy Trinity School is over \$5,000 per student. The only way that we can keep our school open and thriving is through the generosity of Holy Trinity, All Souls and Our Lady of the Presentation Parishes and the Archdiocese of Saint Louis. We receive over half of our operating budget from these sources rather than tuition.

The main fundraiser for the school is the Fish Fry, sponsored by our Home &

School Association, held every Friday in Lent except Good Friday. Parents are asked to help twice at a fish fry for every child they have in school, and more often if possible. **You are also asked to send homemade desserts if possible on Thursday or Friday.**
